Judge Anderson informed everyone that the municipal judge observed Truancy Court on March 20 and would like to continue attending.

*Data committee: Looking at data on drug offense related cases and jail numbers.

Drug Court Presentation:

Heather Fick, Rusk County Drug Court Coordinator, presented a video and PowerPoint on Rusk County Drug Court. Heather stated a goal is to get information out about Drug Court and to be county funded in 2021 after the grant expires. A committee member commented on Drug Court being one of Rusk County's best kept secrets and how do we get the word out.
