Review Bylaws

HOPE Consortium Agreement

Discussion held. Agreement reviewed and signed by Kalepp at the Justice, Youth and Extension Committee meeting on July 10, 2024; no signature obtained from Sheriff Wallace. Request from Vice Chair Gauger to remove Sheriff Wallace as the signatory due to his recent resignation as chairman and replace the signatory with himself as vice chair. *Motion by Hon. A. Barna, second by Hon. B. Stewart to change the signatory from Sheriff Wallace to Vice Chair Gauger and submit the HOPE Consortium Agreement. Motion carried.*

Marshfield Community Grant

Heath updated the committee on the grant and the funds remaining; approximately \$1,900.00. The grant money will be spent by Recovery Court to purchase items to be used during community outreach events.

Verbal update to the committee that the Public Defenders office has relocated from Barron County to Chippewa County and the office is now fully staffed.
