1 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.22(1), the Board must establish the total
2 annual compensation for services to be paid to county elected officials (other
3 than supervisors and circuit judges) prior to the earliest time for filing nomination
4 papers for the county elective offices and;

6 **WHEREAS**, the Board desires to establish the total annual compensation for
7 county elected officials, which is separate and distinct from the fringe benefits
8 offered by the County to elected officials, and which fringe benefits are subject to
9 increase or decrease during the officer's term at the discretion of the Board and in
10 accordance with state and federal law and;

12 **WHEREAS**, as part of the County's fringe benefit program, county elected
13 officials may participate in the Wisconsin Retirement System in accordance with
14 state law and;

16 **WHEREAS**, as part of the County's fringe benefit program, county elected
17 officials may elect to receive health insurance coverage under the same terms and
18 conditions as the health insurance coverage offered to non-represented
19 managerial county employees who are not law enforcement managerial
20 employees or non-represented managerial employees described in Wis. Stat. §
21 111.70(1)(mm)2 and;

23 **WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the Personnel Committee to recommend
24 salaries for elected officials to the Board for final approval; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the Personnel Committee has reviewed the elected officials salaries
27 and recommends the following salaries starting on January 1, 2023 as follows;

47 required by law; and

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
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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the aforementioned county elected officials are entitled to participate in the County's health insurance program subject to the terms and conditions of the program, which may be modified from time to time, under the same terms and conditions as the health insurance coverage offered to non-represented managerial county employees who are not law enforcement managerial employees or non-represented managerial employees described in Wis. Stat. § 111.70(1)(mm)2.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the elected officials listed above shall be subject to the provision of the fringe benefit programs as set forth in the County Employee Handbook, except as otherwise required by State Law.


