1 **WHEREAS**, the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of the Jump River.
 2 This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of Rusk County; and
 3
 4 **WHEREAS**, the intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for
 5 the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests and the
 6 capability of the water resources; and
 7
 8 **WHEREAS**, state boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by
 9 reference; and
 10
 11 **WHEREAS**, Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in s. 30.80 Wis. Stats., and
 12 deposits established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established in the
 13 Wisconsin Judicial Conferences, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to
 14 fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted; and
 15
 16 **WHEREAS**, The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is
 17 expressly declared that Rusk County would have passed the other provisions of this
 18 ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared
 19 invalid. If any provisions of this ordinance or the application to any person or
 20 circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of
 21 such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected; and
 22
 23 **WHEREAS**, no person shall operate a boat, as defined in s. 30.50(6), Wis. Stats., on the
 24 waters of the Jump River within the right of way at the crossing of County Highway G
 25 during the bridge construction project. The boat restriction area will be in place from
 26 May 1, 2021 to September 30, 2021; and
 27
 28 **WHEREAS**, Rusk County shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all
 29 public access points within the jurisdiction of the County pursuant to the requirements
 30 of NR 5.15, Wis. Adm. Code.
 31
 32 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, this ordinance shall take effect on May 1, 2021;
 33 and
 34
 35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, this ordinance will therefore sunset at midnight on October
 36 1, 2021 unless otherwise amended, rescinded, or extended by future action by the Rusk
 37 County Board of Supervisors.
