RESOLUTION # **2\ - 30**MEDICAL EXAMINER STAFFING AND COMPENSATION ADJUSTMENTS

TO THE RUSK COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, Rusk County operates a Medical Examiner office staffed by a parttime Medical Examiner and Deputy Medical Examiners (3), and

WHEREAS, the current Medical Examiner position is a 29-hour a week salaried exempt position and the Chief Deputy Medical Examiner and Deputy Medical Examiner are compensated with a monthly per diem, stipend payment per death investigation, and an hourly pay for assigned work and transports, and

WHEREAS, due to increased demands on the work of the medical examiner's office it is critical to maintain adequate, competent, and professional staffing, and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Services and Personnel Committee have reviewed the needs of the Medical Examiner office and determined it necessary to adjust the hours of the Medical Examiner position and compensation of Deputy Medical Examiners; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to make the Medical Examiner a full-time salary exempt position; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to increase the Chief Deputy ME monthly per diem from \$425 to \$525 per month, increase Deputy ME monthly per diem from \$110 to \$200, increase the stipends for death investigation from \$117 to \$185 (simple) and \$167 to \$335 (complex), and increase hourly pay (assigned work and transports) from \$11/hr to \$16/hr, and

WHEREAS, based on 2020 staff, staffing levels, and workload the estimated annual fiscal impact of these changes would increase the cost of the Medical Examiner position by \$29,822 (wages and benefits) and the Deputy ME cost by \$17,731 (per diems and stipends), for an estimated total increase of \$47,553.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rusk County Board of Supervisors does hereby approve making the Medical Examiner a full-time position and the compensation adjustments as outlined below.
