3 **WHEREAS**, Rusk County needs to keep wages competitive with other jobs within the

4 County and in the surrounding areas to optimize recruitment and retention; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Ambulance Service will need to continue to offer wages and benefits

7 that draw qualified and well trained Emergency Responders to the County; and

9 **WHEREAS**, a wage adjustment schedule has been recommended (below) and based on

10 the 2021 call data the annual fiscal impact of the proposed wage increase would be an

11 increase of \$6,800.49.

13 **WHEREAS**, previous resolution 21-34 provided that Ambulance Service employees will

14 receive any across the board increases.

16 **WHEREAS**, there is not a uniform across the board increase for County employees

17 effective January 1, 2023 due to implementation of the wage study performed for General

18 County employees
