



**TRAIL'S END CAMP  
CABIN CAPACITY**

There must be at least 3 feet horizontally between bunks, at least 6 feet horizontally between the heads of sleepers, and 2.5 feet of head space above the top mattress. Bunks measure 2.5' wide and 7' long.

Cabins have been measured and maximum capacity is as follows:
