Meeting called to order at 7:32 AM by CJCC President Jeremy Jacobs with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Update on DNA Samples: No update at this time.

Discussion with evaluators of Drug Court: No update at this time.

Subcommittee Goals: Jeremy provided an update on the Youth Justice Committee goals. Jeremy reviewed the members of each subcommittee. Melissa agreed to be on the Criminal Justice and Data Subcommittees. The list may need to be updated. Jeremy would like to meet with Data Committee on OWI surcharge allocations paid to the county and what the funds can be used on. Marsy's Law: Judge provided an update from the Records Management Committee and at this time how difficult it has been to create new forms. At this time, there is a struggle with procedurally how to implement the forms.

Probation and Parole update on new revocation process: Melissa stated the revocation packets are all being converted to electronic format. This conversion should help the agents with time also. Melissa updated the committee on the summary form (how it generates and what it looks like). DOC is still working on the forms and updating as necessary.

General Conversation: Rich stated that RRYP current case load is higher than it was all of last year. The vast majority of violations are vaping, tobacco and underage alcohol. Rich stated that Escape the Vape program rolls out June 28. Discussion held on the Prime for Life program and what age to implement program. Craig questioned and a discussion held on how you counter the attitude/culture in the home. Discussion held on Truancy implementation in schools.

Judge informed the committee that the Drug Court Coordinator is retiring effective July 1.
