

MINUTES
CJCC MEETING
August 19, 2021
Meeting held via Zoom

Present were: Judge Anderson, Karie Kennedy, Jeremy Jacobs, Holly Parker, Jessica Flater, Judge Stewart, Dave Willingham, Cassandra Clark, Mark Schmitt, Nancy Hahn, Laurie Leaf, Lori Gorsegrner.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Jeremy Jacobs with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:30 a.m.

A motion to approve prior month minutes was made by Judge Stewart. Second by Jessica Flater. Carried unanimously.

- Holly reported the Drug Court team is transitioning from Aurora to Anchor Bay starting September 1, 2021. Michelle Sanderson and Ruth Pooler will be working at Anchor Bay. Andy Wolf will also be leaving Aurora. Jeremy is very excited to have another mental health provider in Rusk Co. Judge Stewart feels there should be contracts with both facilities. Jeremy stated he will work with Anchor Bay to get a contract. Judge Stewart is encouraging accountability measures and data as Aurora has failed to provide the information to us. Jeremy would like to see data on treatment court and domestic violence. Judge Anderson will be talking with Anchor Bay on getting a domestic abuse prevention program started in Rusk Co.
- Jeremy reported on the CCS meeting that was held this week. This program will come along side the treatment court program with a mental health and AODA recovery plans. He feels this program is very positive for those in treatment court.
- Holly stated she met with the principal investigator, Janae Goodrich, of the TAD grant. The estimated proposal cost for the program evaluation would be \$22,500. This came in much higher than anticipated. Holly mentioned it could be possible to write the cost into the upcoming grant, or the upcoming budget. Dave suggested using ARPA funds to pay for it as well.
- Jessica Flater stated she will be going to a WJCIA conference with Rich Green and Judge Stewart. They will be traveling to Wisconsin Dells for this conference.
- Starting September 15th a different committee will report each month on their accomplishments. Each committee will report as follows:
 1. September 16, 2021 – Juvenile Court Review Committee
 2. October 21, 2021 – Grant Funding Committee
 3. November 18, 2021 – Program Review Committee
 4. December 16, 2021 – Criminal Court Review Committee
 5. January 20, 2022 – Data Committee

- Laurie Leaf reported they will not be offering virtual schooling to anyone this year that isn't quarantined.
- Jeremy asked members of CJCC to send the public to HHS if they need fuel assistance. They should contact Becky Tucker.
- Jeremy stated the CDC is developing a new list as to the 3rd dose of the vaccine. HHS is suggesting the public see their primary care providers. As of today, Public Health is still giving vaccines to the public. Dave Willingham stated the news is saying a 3rd dose should be given after 8 months.
