CJCC MEETING  
February 20, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Chair Jeremy Jacobs with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:30 a.m.

A motion to approve prior month minutes was made by Judge Anderson. Second by George Murray. Carried unanimously.

- Jeremy Jacobs welcomed and introduced Rich Gauger with RRYP. Annette explains to the members of CJCC that Rich will be very busy as there was a reduction in hours to the position. Annette requested that Rich be sent to the MRT training in Stevens Point in May. Jeremy feels this is a very good idea. Holly will send the email she received regarding the training to Jeremy and Rich. Rich will see Annette for more information on this training. Kevin requested that Rich come with him to talk with the Municipal Judge about truancy citations and truancy court.
- Judge Stewart requested review of the by-laws be added to this month's agenda. This will be brought up at the next month's meeting as Judge Stewart wasn't able to be here today. Dave suggested that the Domestic Abuse Coordinator be added to the by-laws. Another suggestion was to add someone from Aurora Community Counseling. Jeremy will email Aurora regarding this, and will also email the current by-laws to everyone.
- Annette is requesting a different oversight committee for the District Attorney's office. She explained how she feels there is a misunderstanding of what the Court needs. Members of CJCC discussed what committee it should go to. Judge and Annette feel strongly there should be a committee formed for just the Court with a member of the community on it. Dave would like to see this go to the County Board in March. Judge Anderson will talk with others to see what is done in other counties. Annette will send an email out on list serve to see what other counties are doing.
- Committee Reports:

Juvenile Justice: Jeremy stated there is a sub-committee meeting today with all local schools. He is hopeful to get a truancy plan in place. He will have more information next month.
