CJCC MEETING  
January 16, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Chair Jeremy Jacobs with the citing of the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:30 a.m.

A motion to approve prior month minutes was made by Judge Stewart. Second by Jessica Flater. Carried unanimously.

- Jeremy Jacobs welcomed and introduced Mike Noel with Precision Kiosk Technologies. Mike played a video and showed a power point presentation on how the automated alcohol screening kiosk that we are currently using in Rusk County works. Mike showed in detail how the kiosk captures photos and video of each check-in, delivers questions to offenders and captures their responses, and alerts staff when a check-in is missed, or when a test comes back positive. George said that Rusk County is currently using this technology, and finds it to be very user friendly. George said there are 4 offenders using it at this time, and would like to see more using it in the future. Judge Anderson feels that the cost to use it is minimal, and likes that it sends text notifications to clients reminding them of their appointment. Judge Anderson would like to see some of the Drug Court participants use this as well. George is hoping to get Probation and Parole on board using it in the future. Holly, the Drug Court Coordinator will also be meeting with Mike to discuss using the kiosk. Judge Stewart would like to get feedback from CJCC members on how the kiosk is working at an upcoming meeting.
