CJCC MEETING
September 16, 2021
Meeting held via Zoom

The meeting was called to order by Chair Jeremy Jacobs with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:31 a.m.

A motion to approve prior month minutes was made by George Murray. Second by Judge Stewart. Carried unanimously.

- Members of CJCC welcome Nancy Campbell-Kelz and Heather Lutze with Aurora Community Counseling. Nancy has a strong passion for creating and maintaining programming vital to community safety, mental health, and substance use. Jeremy would like Karie to send Nancy a list of the sub-committees. Nancy can let Jeremy know what sub-committee she'd like to be on.
- Holly stated she is still working with the principal investigator, Janae Goodrich, on the treatment court evaluation process. The cost for the program evaluation is \$22,500. This evaluation will take place over the next five years. Rich Gauger requested to see a finished evaluation that she's done for other counties. Jeremy requested that Holly get a copy of one of her finished products to show the members of CJCC. Judge Stewart feels a new evaluation is needed as the standard time is every 5 years. Nancy has experience with an office in Medford where Holly could check for a 2nd opinion on cost.
- Rich Green reported on the Youth Justice Sub-Committee this month. The sub-committee has been working on following the statue to structure this committee along with the Ladysmith School and area principals to get this process done. They are discussing issues with area schools and law enforcement on vaping, truancy, and sexting. Rich Gauger is currently working on a lot of juvenile alcohol citations. The committee is working on a grant through Walmart. This should be worked through at a stakeholder's committee level. Jessica Flater, Rich Green and Judge Stewart will be going to a WJCIA conference in Wisconsin Dells.
- Dave addresses the letter he wrote regarding improving or defining CJCC. He would like to challenge everyone to rethink what CJCC can do to have a more of active roll in coordinating how departments and agencies work together. Melissa shares her experience with CJCC in Dunn County, and feels the sub-committees is where the work gets done. Judge Stewart also gives his opinions as he's had experience in Dunn County as well. This subject will be talked about at next month's meeting.
- The next committee to report on their accomplishments will be the Program Review Committee. Jeremy agrees to move the Grant Funding Committee to February. Please report as follows:
