CJCC MEETING
November 17, 2022
Meeting held via Zoom

The meeting was called to order by Judge Stewart with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:32 a.m.

Judge Stewart welcomed and thanked Janae and Caleb for appearing today. They are with UW Madison and did our Drug Court evaluation. Janae hit the high spots by showing a PowerPoint presentation. She explained the mixed methods approach that was used for the evaluation. Caleb explained the admission and discharge process along with recidivism analysis findings. Janae explained the strengths, challenges and the opportunities for improvement of the program. Judge Barna gave an overview and clarification of the Drug Court program to the members. Judge Stewart feels that all members of CJCC need to be more informed and learn more about the program. Dave questioned Janae as to recidivism and feels it would be a good idea to know more about the background of participants once they have graduated. Janae feels that possibly adding a graduate to the team might help to get to know what graduates need for after care. Janae feels it's important to share the success stories of graduates with the public.

Judge Stewart will look for the program evaluation that was done in Dunn Co. and have it sent out again. He's asking all members to read the evaluations and have questions at the next meeting. He's also asking Chelsea to have a list of things she needs from CJCC to make the program more successful in terms of overall support and/or financial support. Members should also be prepared to discuss in person meetings for CJCC in the upcoming New Year.
