CJCC MEETING  
October 20, 2022  
Meeting held via Zoom

Present were: Karie Kennedy, Judge Barna, Judge Stewart, Rich Gauger, Rich Green, Jeremy Jacobs, Chelsea Korzenieski, Jessica Flater, Lori Gorsegrner, Sheriff Wallace, Melissa Buesgen, Craig Voldberg, Michael Derr, Marsha Schiszik

The meeting was called to order by Chair Jeremy Jacobs with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:33 a.m.

A motion to approve prior month minutes was made by Rich Gauger. Second by Judge Stewart. Carried unanimously.  
(Correction noted that Jeremy went to Stevens Point for the training on the Opioid Settlement Funds.)

Introduction of TAD visitors: Michael Derr and Marsha Schiszik introduced themselves and gave an overview of the TAD program. There was discussion of Medicaid requirements and balance billing with Rusk County. Mike assured the members of CJCC that if there are claims submitted that Rusk County will not be responsible for them. Chelsea questioned UA's being done over the weekend. Sheriff Wallace stated the jail staff will not do UA's in the lobby of the jail. He feels that it's a violation of the participant's privacy as they aren't inmates. Jeremy questioned how the drug screening works. Chelsea and Rich responded and both agree that the UA's are most accurate with the fastest results. Chelsea added that a participant must have two random tests in a seven day period. Sheriff questioned if anyone has contact the drug clinic in town to see if they can do the UA's. Judge Barna stated they have talked to them and gave reasons why they can't do it at this time. Marsha stated that she might have some contacts for Chelsea to reach out to on this issue. Judge Barna will be posting two LTE job positions to cover the weekends. Marsha stated this new position could also possibly do some of the data entry as well. Mike added that Chelsea is doing a wonderful job in her new position and is very impressed how committed she is to the Drug Court program.

Letter of Support for Drug Court: Motion to approve made by Rich Gauger. Second by Jeremy Jacobs. Carried unanimously. Judge Stewart made a request to see the grant once it's complete. Chelsea will be send it to all members of CJCC when it's complete.

Committee Reports: Nothing to report from anyone. Jeremy encourages everyone to meet with their committees to get topics going for 2023.

General conversation: Rich Gauger stated how vaping and underage alcohol have become a real issue and there's no break in sight in the number of Teen Court participants. There will be a report on the Drug Court evaluation that was done; Karie is to add this to the next agenda. Chelsea is working on the grant for Drug Court with Crystal. There are currently three Drug Court participants enrolled in the CCS program. Jeremy will be inviting members of this committee and others to discuss how the opioid funds should be spent and talk about what he learned at his training. Jeremy would like to have someone else as Chair of this committee in 2023. This topic will be discussed in the near future.
