

## **RUSK COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS USER RULES SUMMARY**

*The following is adapted from Chapter 36 Article III of the Rusk County Code:*

### **HOURS OF USE:**

Summer Hours: 6:00 am to 10:00 pm

Winter Hours: 6:00 am to 7:00 pm

*Note - Hours may be extended for Special Events as indicated on Usage Agreement.*

- ✓ Littering is prohibited per Section 40-1. Cigarette butts are litter.
- ✓ Recycling is mandatory per Chapter 287, WI Stats. Event holders can get recycling bins at Recycling Office and need to contact Maintenance Staff for disposal needs.
- ✓ Unnecessary Noise and Offensive Conduct is Prohibited.
- ✓ Any animal on the fairgrounds shall be leashed unless otherwise constrained in a pen, cage, or other device restricting the animal's movements. All animal feces shall be collected by the owner or keeper of the animal and removed from the fairgrounds or otherwise disposed of as directed.
- ✓ Horses and other Livestock are restricted to designated areas north of the north restrooms.
- ✓ No advertising posters, banners or flyers, except for ones relating to current event may be posted or displayed without permission.
- ✓ No property owned or in the possession of the county may be removed without permission from Justice & Youth & Extension Committee.
- ✓ No campfires, cooking fires or ceremonial fires or any open flames are allowed except in designated grills or fire pits. See Maintenance staff for approved locations.
- ✓ No smoking or tobacco products allowed in or within 20 feet of any building.
- ✓ Motor vehicles shall be parked in areas designated for parking. Speed limit on all roadways is ten miles per hour.
- ✓ No motor vehicle shall be operated except on roadways within fairgrounds.
- ✓ ATV or off-road vehicles are permitted on the designated roadways provided they are compliant with other rules of the road.
- ✓ No person shall possess any firearm without written permission from the Justice, Youth & Extension Committee or as otherwise permitted by law while on the fairground's premises.
- ✓ Glass beverage containers are prohibited.
- ✓ Camping is prohibited without written permission and limited to areas and times specified in a usage agreement.
- ✓ No person shall dispense or sell alcoholic beverages on the fairgrounds without written permission from the Justice & Youth & Extension Committee.
- ✓ No person shall enter any locked building or any building or area designated as closed to the public.

Any person violating the provisions of Chapter 36 Article III of the Rusk County Code shall be fined in amounts as provided in the county fine and forfeiture schedule plus applicable court costs and assessments.
